PROGRAM

Ward Mitzel introduced this morning's guest speaker, Heather Sands, with Gear Up Ohio. Gear Up (Gaining Early Awareness and Readiness) is a program administered by the Community Foundation as a mechanism to help local students prepare for college. The \$1.6 million – 6-year grant is in its 5th year and has served nearly 2,000 students since its inception. During the 2008-2009 school year, nearly 700 students used the program's tutoring services. Gear Up's services include: mentoring and tutoring; ACT preparation; career advising and financial aid advising.

The concept to the program was founded by Bill Straker, as a clearing house for local scholarships. Today, the program is closely affiliated with Zane State College and the Muskingum Family Y. The program serves local students from 5th grade through college.
