PROGRAM

Janet Stewart introduced today's speaker, Renee' Coll.

Renee' is a graduate of John Glenn High School and Muskingum College and is glad to be back in the area doing business. She and her husband Brian have started a plastic reprocessing facility, Coll Materials. The couple purchased their first machine in July 2008 and set up business in Byesville. In April 2009 they acquired one of their competitors in downtown Detroit and have combined the two operations in their new facility, previously All American Homes at the Airport Exit. They currently reprocess mainly #2 High Density Polyethylene which is used to make water bottle and milk jugs but are looking to expand in

the near future. They have grown to 35 employees working 5 days per week in three shifts.

Their process includes grinding the plastic into 3/8" diameter flakes, washing the material and selling it back to manufacturers.

Renee's also enlightened us with some "plastic" facts. Did you know that only 24% of water bottles get recycled and that plastic makes up 12% of landfill material each year? Have you noticed that our milk jugs and water bottles are thinner than they used to be? That's because 30% less plastic is used to make them.
