The Council formed a committee to distribute books to children in our community and to read to them. The committee reinforces that reading is the greatest gift you can give a child and that reading to a child 20 minutes a day is life-changing.

The committee began by passing out a book with a bunny on the front of it with the theme of "read to your bunny." From that grew Bard the Bunny. Bard is Celtic for storyteller and he travels around promoting literacy. Bard made his debut during National Literacy Week with a parade of over 200 children in downtown Zanesville and has been on the move ever since. He has been to the Dresden Library, the Taste of Zanesville, the Y-Bridge Arts Festival and was at our Rotary Family Day this past summer at Park Central. He now has a "camo" vest and will be at the Airport in October to welcome home some of our Military.

Stacey Snider was introduced. She is with Mid East Career & Technology Center's Public Relations and is the new chair for the Literacy committee. Stacey feels that word of mouth is the best way to spread information about the Literacy Council and reach those individuals who are in need of the program, both children and adults.
