## PROGRAM

Eric Martin introduced Sheriff Matt Lutz who really needed no introduction. Welcome, Sheriff!

Sheriff Lutz noted that 2009 was a good year for drug enforcement activities. The drug unit arrested 48 people on 89 charges. Of this group 41 were males and 7 females. The most notable arrest was for a long-time drug dealer who was high on the chain of command and well-insulated from law enforcement. Sheriff Lutz is proud of what our local law enforcement team and the Central Ohio Drug Task Force has been able to accomplish by working together and sharing resources.

The DARE program continues with young children under the watchful eye of Officer Don Steer. While this program has had some success in preventing kids from turning to drugs or alcohol, it was noted that older kids also benefit from having interaction with a school resource officer assigned to all schools in the county. This officer works through the Health classes to reinforce the prevention message.

Sheriff Lutz addressed the recent change in the way we receive weather advisories in Muskingum County. The goal of this effort was to alert citizens when the roads are being negatively impacted by the weather and encourage traveling with caution by using a system that is easy to understand.

The Sheriff took several questions in his remaining time. A speaker's gift was presented.
