## SERGEANT AT ARMS

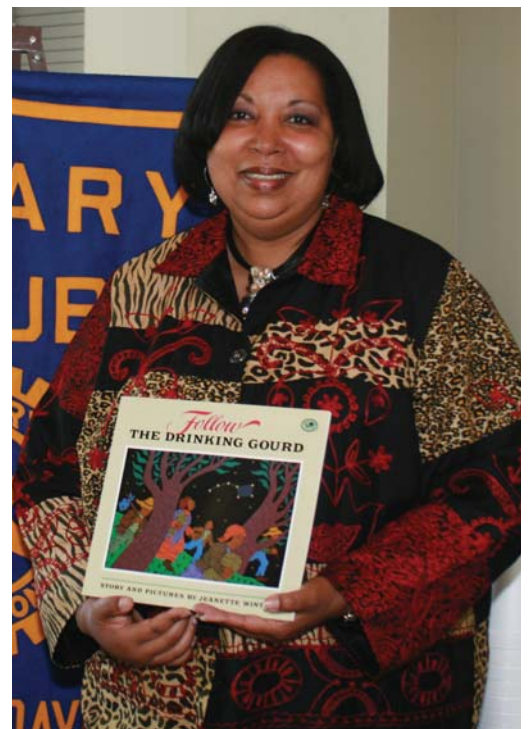
Sgt. Bill Porter had fines all around! Special recognition of Tom Heins as the 1st recipient of the Bill Porter logo award. Way to Tom!

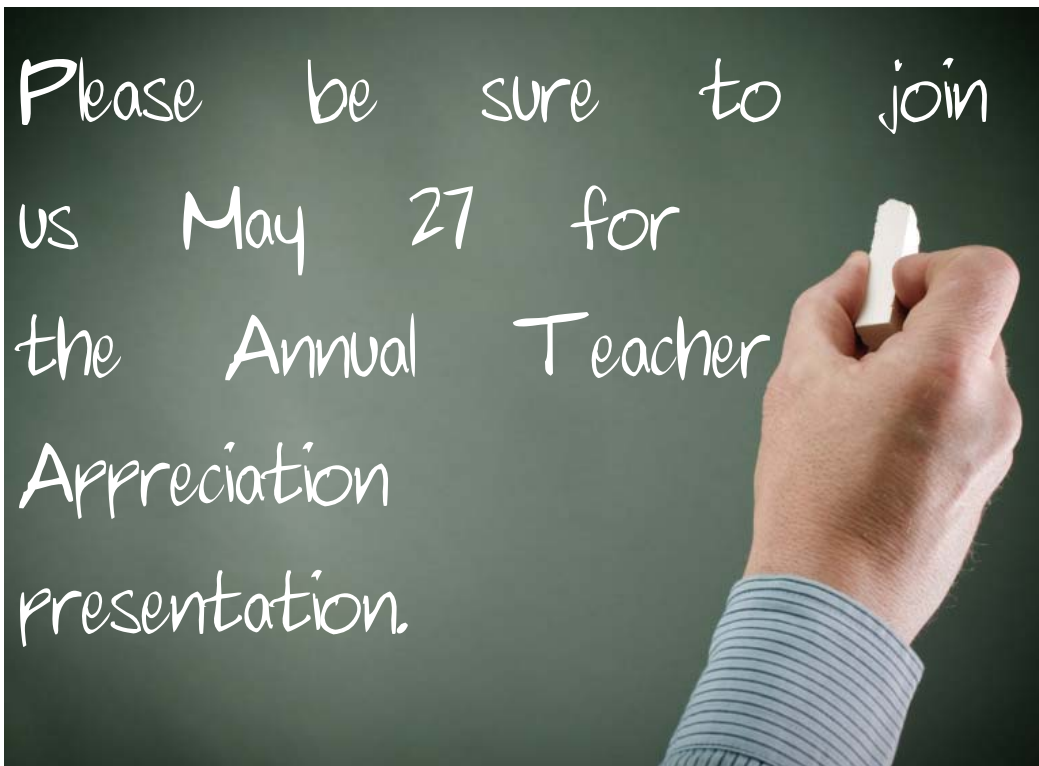
