PROGRAM:

Tom Barone introduced past Rotarian President Dan Sylvester from Quality Care Partners (QCP) a PHO (Physician Hospital Organization). Dan started his career in radiology and continued to build his resume' with a bachelors degree and later a masters degree from Central Michigan. QCP is a comprehensive low cost health service for employers in the Southeastern Ohio area. It does focus on a 10 county area but is capable of extending its boundaries beyond that range when appropriate. Quality Care Partners has teamed up with Ohio Health Group, Health Reach and Care Source to aid in bringing low cost health services to S. E. Ohio. This not-for-profit business has addressed a variety of areas in order to provide a comprehensive package for employers. Here is a list of some of the services they offer: utilization management, case management, disease management, pharmacy management including their own formulary, 24 hour health phone service, and a data warehouse in order to bring all the medical information together. They provide local medical management, local customer service and are committed to a healthier community. Diabetes and obesity are two areas which cost providers a great deal of money because of the complications that come with them. Dan wanted to express that it is very difficult to actually manage health care unless you have some direct connections with the health care providers and hospitals that provide the services.
